Streaming Criteria for the Common Core English Communication (E-Comm) Pathways Academic Year 2024-25

Students are required to complete 6 credits of English Communication (E-Comm) under the Common Core Program. They are streamed into two pathways according to their English qualifications on admission. Pathway 1: for students who have met the English admission requirement

Pathway 2: for students whose proficiency level is beyond the English language admission requirement

Important Notes:

- For any qualification to be valid for streaming, it must have been obtained in the two years before a student is admitted to HKUST, i.e. if the student admitted in 2024, the grade or score must have been obtained in 2022, 2023 or 2024.
- Course streaming should be done based on students' <u>highest qualification obtained</u>. For example, a JEE student with IELTS 6.5 (with no subscore lower than 6.0) should be streamed to <u>Pathway 2</u>, instead of Pathway 1.
- For submission of English Language qualifications for streaming, students please present physical true copy of their public exam results to the Academic Registry (Room 1381, 1/F, Academic Building, Lifts 17-18).
